

29 Glasgow Terms and Conditions

Membership Status

Private and Corporate memberships are available. Please contact a member of management staff to discuss which packages most readily meets your requirements.

Membership period runs for a maximum of 12 months.

29 is aimed at professional individuals aged 30 and over.

Membership is subject to approval by our membership committee only.

New members must be referred by an existing member or a member of the committee or management.

Members must supply us with a current passport photograph for our records.

Companies wishing to arrange corporate membership at 29 should contact the club directly via telephone or letter in the first instance.

Corporate Membership

Corporate applicants must be nominated by their employer upon acceptance of the employing company as a corporate member. Individual members are required to settle any debts incurred use of the club unless otherwise approved by club directors.

Guests

Members may sign-in 2 guests. On special occasions members may be granted the facility to sign in additional guests if discussed and agreed with the membership management at least 24 hours in advance. Members are responsible for the behaviour of their guests.

All cardholder benefits are subject to the door policy and capacity at 29

On a Friday and Saturday evening entrance non-members will be subject to a cover charge after 10pm

Restaurant

Members are welcome to invite non-members to dine within our Chophouse and Grill. These guests can then accompany members within the venue for the remainder of the evening.

Members are not permitted to leave the premises without the non-member guests they have signed in on that day.

Events

Members will be offered a full event management service and preferential rates for a Corporate and Private functions. Non- members may book out our facilities mid week for corporate events only.

Conduct

It is expected that all members and guests of members will behave in a polite, proper and respectful fashion at all times whilst on the premises. Management reserve the right to refuse admission.

If your card is lost please notify us as soon as possible and we will cancel your card number and issue a replacement

If your card is transfer to a non-member for usage, your membership at 29 with automatically be cancelled.
